
Chord Inversions

Chord name stays the same as you move up and down the neck with the finger form inversions as shown.

(follow the vertical arrows)



Home Base Chord Form

The note on the first string and the chord name are the same. In this example the note on the first string at the 5th fret is G, and the chord name is G. This is Home Base because the chord family (G, C, D) is in the Key of G.

Note:

The finger forms indicated are for major chords. The inversions for minor and seventh chords would be similar.
